Governance Pillars of the Liberian Farmers Corporation  
(LFC)

An international nonprofit organization is built on three essential pillars: Structure, Policy, and Framework. Together, they form the "Three-Legged Stool" of institutional stability.

## 1. The Structure (The Bone System)

**Definition:** The formal hierarchy and departmentalization of the organization. It defines roles, reporting lines, and mandates.

- **Focus:** People and Responsibility.
- **In the LFC:** Includes the VPs, Regional Coordinators, and Village Liaisons.
- **Primary Benefit: Efficiency.** Removes operational overlap and ensures every team member knows their specific duties and who to report to.

## 2. The Policy (The Law)

**Definition:** The set of governing rules and ethical standards that dictate behavior and decision-making.

- **Focus:** Rules, Compliance, and Ethics.
- **In the LFC:** Anti-Corruption, Procurement, Gender Inclusion, and Code of Conduct.

- **Primary Benefit: Integrity.** Protects the organization from liability and ensures fair treatment for all members regardless of location.

### 3. The Framework (The Blueprint)

**Definition:** The strategic methodology or "how-to" guide for achieving specific goals.

- **Focus:** Strategy, Process, and Logics.
- **In the LFC:** Member Engagement Framework, M&E Framework, or Seed Distribution logic.
- **Primary Benefit: Scalability.** Provides a repeatable recipe for success that allows the LFC to expand to new regions without losing quality.
